



Rev. Dr. Wilson has taught a video-based study on the Gospel of Matthew for the season of Lent. The Gospel of Matthew tells a unique story of the good news about Jesus from a Jewish perspective. Rev. Dr. Wilson will explore through six sessions how to look at this gospel in a new way. The original audience of Matthew's Gospel was primarily Jewish. What can this gospel teach us about Jesus, the early followers of Jesus, and ultimately ourselves about our journey of faith to follow in the footsteps of Jesus. This study will look at the Gospel of Matthew from a rabbinical perspective.
